#### PRAYERS FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

A group of Christians in the Kandy District of Central Province, Sri Lanka, were prevented from holding a Sunday morning service by a group of Buddhist monks. The believers were holding their meeting at the home of their pastor, but the monks surrounded the house and demanded that the church cease its activities. Later that day, as the pastor and other church leaders tried to meet, another group of monks tried to surround the house. Police intervened to prevent violence but held the church leaders responsible for escalating the situation. A Barnabas Aid contact in Sri Lanka asks, "Please pray for divine protection, spiritual strength, and unwavering faith during this time of persecution."
